ACT: used as a college entrance requirement, scholarship funding, and scores developed for English, Mathematics, Science, and Reading are used as a projection of skills in the respective college-level classes in English Composition, College Algebra, College Biology, and Social Sciences; testing requires approximately 3-3½ hours

[NOTE: Per Tennessee State Board of Education action, beginning in 2017.18SY ALL students enrolled in public schools must complete ACT (or SAT) prior to graduation. The March, 2019, date meets this mandate during a school day.

[NOTE: For 2018-19SY [as funded annually]—\*TN Dept of Education has authorized current 2018.19 Seniors, who as Juniors took ACT, will be allowed to re-take testing. Students interested in re-test should contact their school's counselor to pursue application process. These results should be available to parents and schools within 6 weeks of test administration date.

<u>AIMSweb Universal Screener:</u> administered to measure foundational reading and mathematics skill progress in grades K-8; testing requires up to 30 minutes in grades K-8

Projected data reporting is immediately following testing to parents for student scoring at or below 25%ile

Elementary School Benchmarks: administered to measure degree of success on state standards in reading and mathematics in grades K-5; testing requiring 20-40 minutes [depending on grade level] using Study Island platform

**<u>Projected</u>** data reporting is for parents to receive results immediately following testing.

August 17-September 2, 2018 fall December 1-21, 2018 winter March 6-17, 2019 spring

<u>Middle School Benchmarks</u>: administered online during the regular 90-minute block to measure degree of success on state standards in reading and mathematics in grades 6-8.

August 15 – September 2, 2018 fall March 27 – April 13, 2019 spring

End of Course Formative Assessments: administered online during the 90-minute block in which the student has the EOC class to aid determination of mastery of standards addressed in the initial 9 weeks of each semester.

#### **HOME SCHOOL Students:**

Home school students are permitted to take Advanced Placement [AP] & Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test / National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test [PSAT/NMSQT] exams in public schools where they are administered. Publication of dates of the administration are to be posted on school websites where applicable. [TCA 49-6-3050(f)]

Independent home school students who are in grade 5 or 7 can take TN Ready achievement tests at the public school for which they would normally be zoned. Contact is normally made in early second semester of the school year using current database lists obtained from the Sumner County Attendance Department, where home school registrations are made. That contact relates procedural guidelines to be followed by parents. [TCA 49-6-3050(b)5(A&B)]

Independent home school students who are in grade 9 taking Algebra I and/or English I [specifically named courses] can take TN Ready end-of-course tests at the public school for which they would normally be zoned during the spring testing window. Contact is normally made in early second semester of the school year using current database lists obtained from the Sumner County Attendance Department, where home school registrations are made. That contact relates procedural guidelines to be followed by parents. [TCA 49-6-3050(b)5(A&B)]
